1 Thessalonians 5:18 (ESV)

Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. Christmas is right around the corner. But first, we celebrate a holiday we call Thanksgiving. One can find more than 100 verses about thanks in the OT and more than 70 in the NT. To the original Hebrew mindset, thanksgiving is 100% tied to who God is. The Greek word for thanks gives us the word "eucharist," commonly called "communion." That meal reminds us of who Christ is and what He did for us. As we get closer to Thanksgiving Day, I encourage you to thank God for at least one thing each day. As you do, remember how what you are thankful for is tied to God and what He has done for us in Christ.
