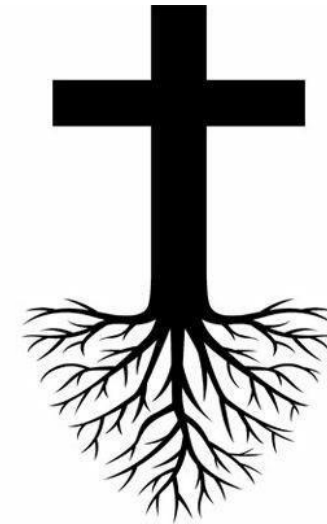
He Grew the Tree!
